WHICH RESEARCH METHODS TO USE?

This document provides a tool to help guide you think about which research methods are likely to be most appropriate based on the purpose of your research or evaluation.

This document provides guidance only and therefore consideration should be given to the appropriateness and practicalities of the suggested research methods.

Each of the research methods is linked to a separate document that provides more information on the use of these methods.

In using any of the suggested, or other available, research methods due consideration should be given to <u>ethical considerations</u>. In particular whether the methods are appropriate for the situation or the types of people they are to be used on; and the necessary information that needs to be provided and the permission required, along with processes to ensure compliance with data protection requirements and not using the information beyond its stated purpose.
